THE DECISION TO BELIEVE

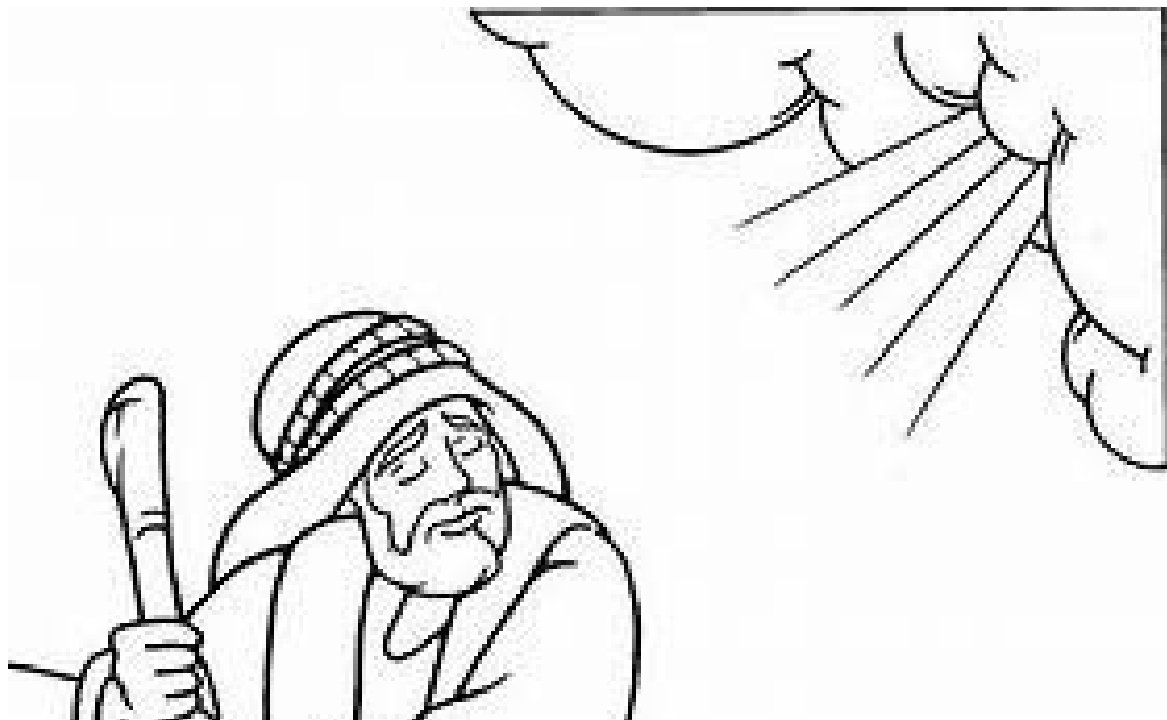
The Lord had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.

Today, we're starting a series about important choices that can change our lives and bring us true happiness. Let's start with the first choice: The Decision to Believe. We're going to learn about Abraham and how believing in God led him to a life full of blessings



God asked Abraham to leave his home and go to a new place he didn't know. This was a big step of faith because Abraham didn't know what would happen.

Stepping Out: Sometimes, God asks us to leave our comfort zone. Faith means trusting God even when things seem uncertain.

Finding Purpose: God has a special plan for each of us, and it's revealed when we listen and follow Him.

Journey of Faith: Our journey with God involves taking one step at a time and trusting Him with each step.

Facing Challenges: Faith helps us deal with tough times and makes us stronger.

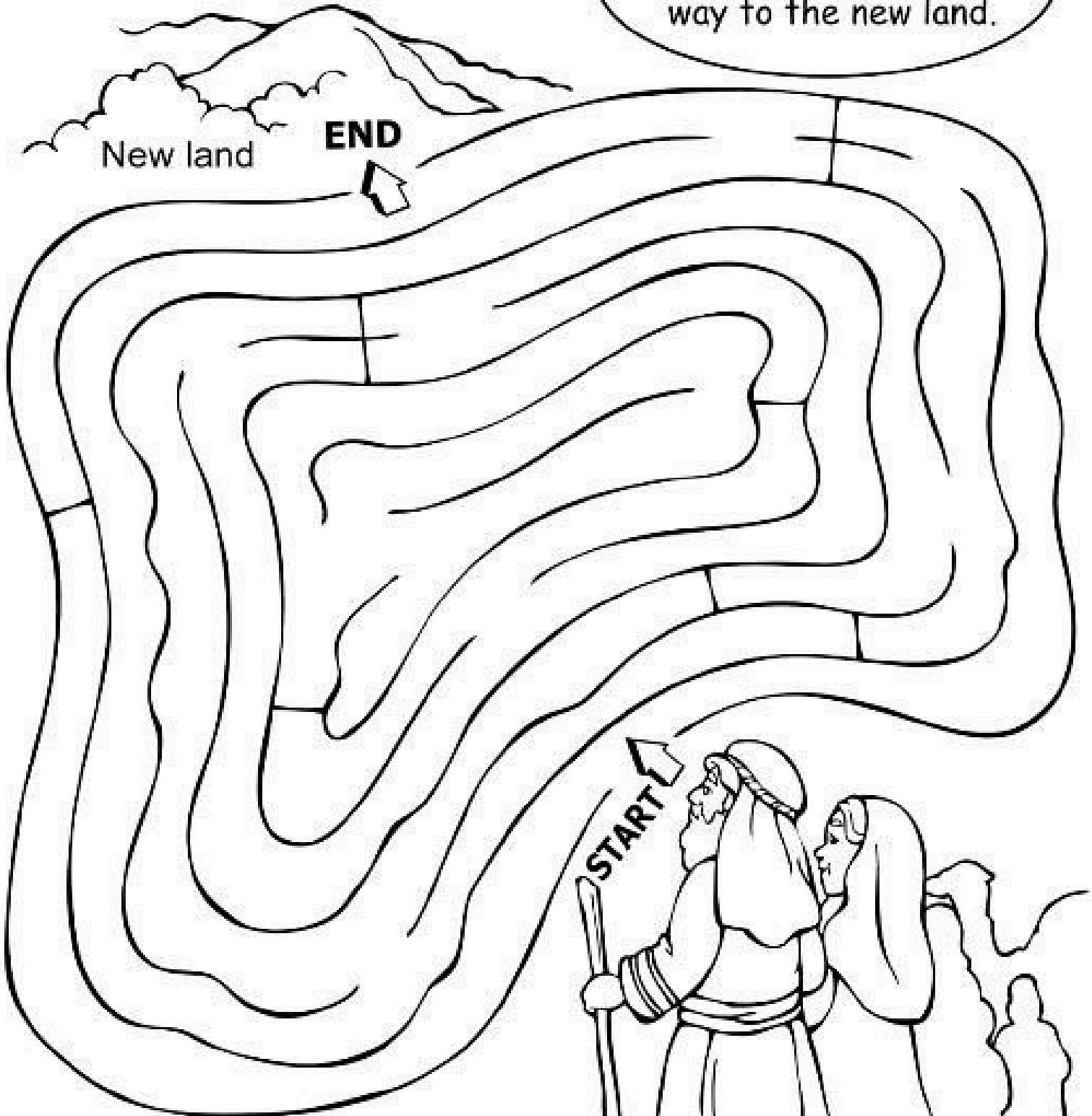
Rewards: Following God brings us many rewards, including joy and peace, beyond just material
